

Vertical Alignment Properties - Baseline Shift

This document tests vertical alignment of inline elements. The test consists of several lines of text; line height is 30 pt. Each line is structured as follows:

- gray background marks the unshifted line;
- black border marks an inline shifted by the amount specified by the first word inside it. This box serves as a reference to all other elements;
- yellow background marks a nested inline unshifted from the reference box. The rectangle should contain the word "unshifted" and be aligned within the reference box;
- light blue background marks an inline shifted from the reference box by the specified amount.

To facilitate test interpretation, a ruler is drawn at the left of the text.
