Plain lists

- ✓ This is the second entry in a plain unordered list. A check symbol is displayed in the bullet.
- ✓ This is the third entry in a plain unordered list. A check symbol is displayed in the bullet.
- ✓ This is the fourth entry in a plain unordered list. A check symbol is displayed in the bullet.
- ✓ This is the fifth entry in a plain unordered list. A check symbol is displayed in the bullet.

Provisional-distance-between-starts and provisional-label-separation attributes

1.	distance-between-starts = 2 in label-separation = 0 in
2.	distance-between-starts = 2.25 in label-separation = 0.5 in
3.	distance-between-starts = 2.5 in label-separation = 1 in
4.	distance-between-starts = 2.75 in label-separation = 1.5 in
5.	distance-between-starts = 3 in label-separation = 2 in

Start-indent and end-indent attributes on list-item / list-body

end-indent = 3 in	start-indent = 4.5 in
end-indent = 3.5 in	start-indent = 4 in
end-indent = 4 in	start-indent = 3.5 in
end-indent = 4.5 in	start-indent = 3 in
